- C. Attendance Policy
 - a. Practice attendance policy- Upon commencement of WPYFL Heat Acclimation Week, practice attendance is mandatory. Athletes are permitted a maximum of two absences. Any missed practice, particularly those covering new material (e.g., stunts), may result in a safety assessment by the coaching staff to determine the athlete's eligibility to participate. When WPYFL Heat Acclimation Week is announced by the WPYFL, the GLSD Youth Cheer Board will announce via the BAND app, as well as through our <u>mailing list</u>. -
 - July 28, 2025 is WPYFL Heat Acclimation week for the 2025 season.
 Starting July 28, 2025, practice attendance is mandatory and no more than 2 absences will be permitted.

- b. Game attendance policy- Absences from a game will result in the athlete sitting out the first quarter of the subsequent game. A doctor's note is required to excuse absences due to illness and avoid this consequence.
